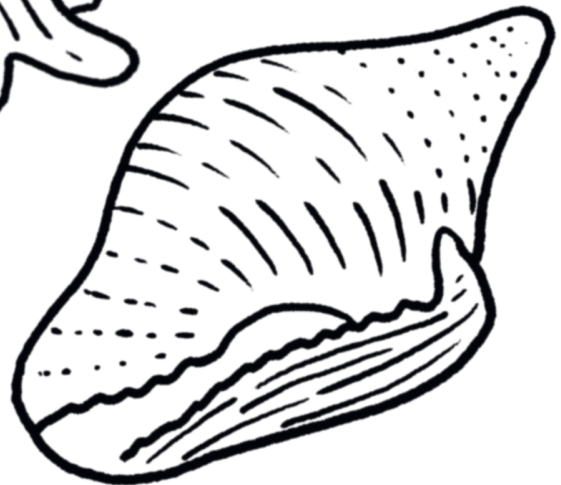
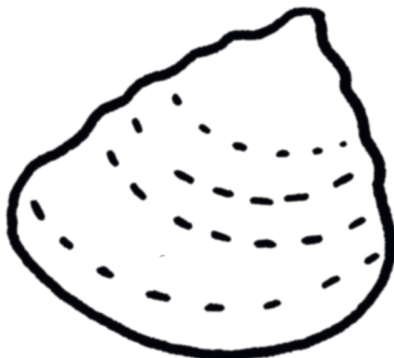
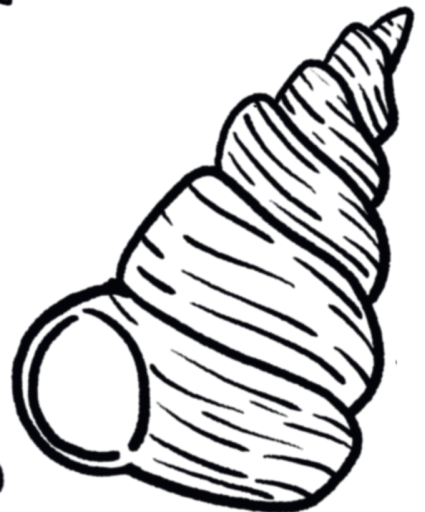
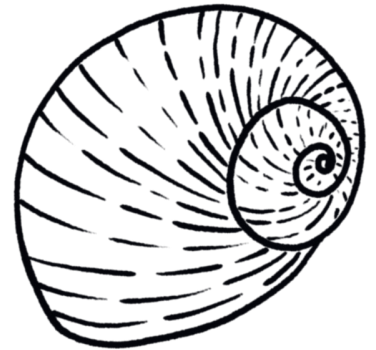
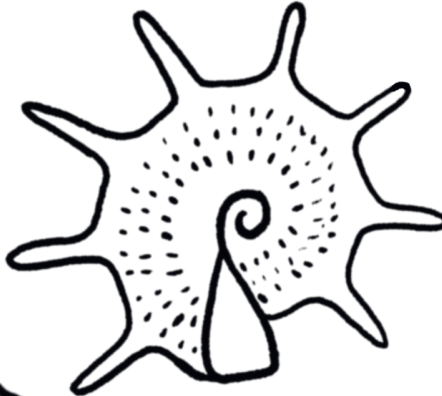
UNDER THE SEA

INSTRUCTIONS



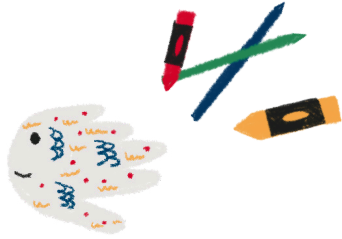
Place your hand on a piece of paper. Trace the outline of your hand with the marker.



Cut out the hand from the paper using the scissors.



Draw the fish's eye and mouth on the base of the hand outline (not the side with the fingers).



Decorate your fish with the crayons and colored pencils.

Glue the fish onto a popsicle stick.



FAST FACT

There are over 15,000 different species of fish that live in the sea!

KEEP IT GOING!

Experiment decorating your fish with different materials like pompoms, string, cotton balls, and sequins.

Also experiment tracing your family's hands to make fish of all different sizes.



Repeat steps 1-5 until you have enough fish puppets to put on a show!

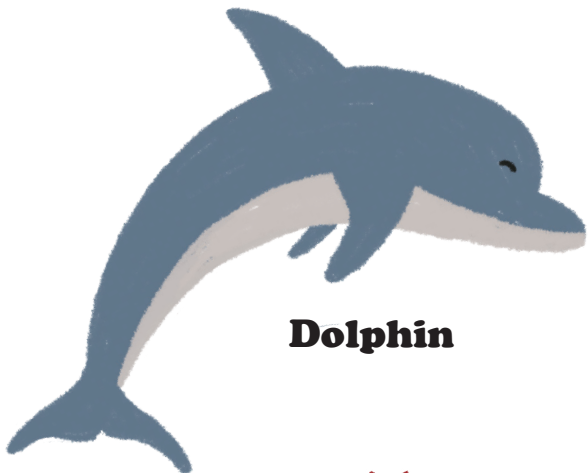
PUT ON A SHOW!

Check your answers on the last page!



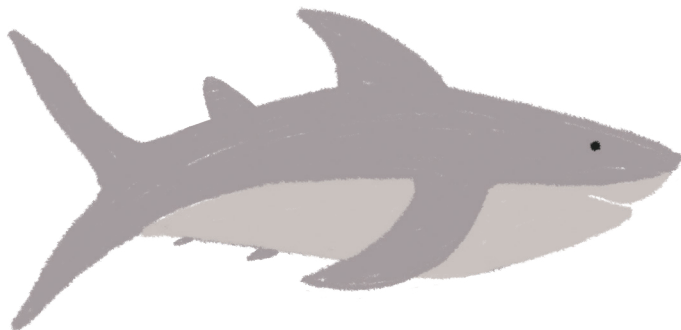

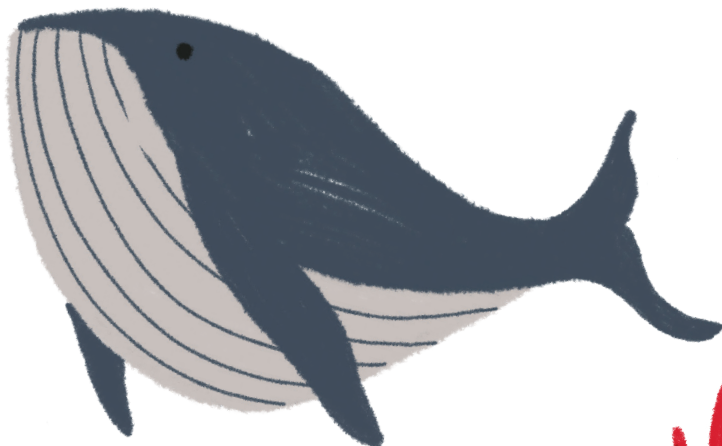

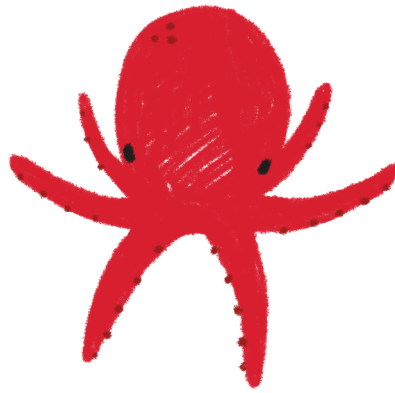
